A statement of candidacy which addresses the specific award criteria, achievements and notable impacts listed on the external organization's awards website – refer to specific award criteria.
Nominees should demonstrate excellence in all criteria listed.
2 page letter of support from the nominees Departmental Chair or Vice Chair of Education
Complete and up to date CV
Teaching Dossier/Creative Professional Activities (CPA) Dossier (if applicable) and Summary of Relevant Teaching and/or Course Evaluations
2 additional letters of support
Two letters of support from colleagues/peers and or learners/trainees. (Separate from the letter of support from Departmental Chair/Vice Chair, Education). Each letter should not exceed 2 pages.
Additional supportive/supplemental documentation/materials can be submitted at the discretion of the nominee/nominator. Such documents include: examples of educational innovations and or examples of education scholarship activity, etc. <u>These should not exceed 10 pages.</u>

The above requirements and supporting documents listed should be submitted online via the External Education and Teaching Awards nomination form.
