Awards Allocated to Undergraduate Departments/Students

Undergraduate Research Opportunity Program (UROP) (see table below)

Graduate and Life Sciences Education Office will oversee the UROP award allocations for 10 departments within the Faculty of Medicine. Support is set at \$2,000 per student. The students must be guaranteed at least an additional \$2,000 in compensation from other sources managed by the sponsoring department / centre / institute / program, and are expected to engage in full-time research for at least 12 weeks. In addition, there is a new summer research award, the Dr. John P. Mitchell Award under disease area Cancer. Each department will be allocated one extra award valued at \$20,000 from this trust account.

2. GLSE Undergraduate Summer Research Studentship

Graduate and Life Sciences Education awards 7 annual summer research project studentships to support third or fourth year major and/or specialist students in our Basic Science have equivalent qualifications. This is to provide mentored research opportunities for undergraduate students who undertake an in-depth study in a life sciences programs. Each department receives one studentship per summer to be awarded to a student the department selects based on excellent academic merit and interest in future graduate training. The awards carry a value of \$4,800 each.

University of Toronto Excellence Awards (NSERC & SSHRC) (see table below)

The University of Toronto Excellence Award (UTEA) program is funded by the Vice President Research and Innovation. The UTEA program provides eligible undergraduate students with opportunities to conduct summer research projects under the supervision of eligible U of T faculty members. The value of each UTEA award is \$6,000 and the research term required is 14 weeks.

4. GLSE Undergraduate Leadership Awards

Graduate and Life Sciences Education will award up to three annual Undergraduate Student Leadership Awards in Life Sciences. The purpose of these awards is to provide opportunities for undergraduate students in the Faculty of Medicine to be recognized for their leadership and scholarship and for their outstanding contributions to academic and student life at the University of Toronto. The award carries a value of \$500 each.

5. Undergraduate Faculty Teaching Awards

Graduate and Life Sciences Education, in partnership with the Basic Science Departments and Institutes in the Faculty, will award four annual Undergraduate Teaching Awards in Life Sciences in four categories. The purpose of these awards is to honour outstanding and sustained contributions by faculty members to undergraduate Arts and Science teaching and the undergraduate experience in Life Sciences. The awards carry a cash value of \$1,000 each and will be presented at the Faculty of Medicine Annual Education Achievement Celebration.
