TAHSN RESEARCH ETHICS COMMITTEE (TREC) TASK FORCE ON INSURANCE

Terms of Reference

PURPOSE

A number of important issues have been identified that require clarification regarding insurance coverage relating to clinical research activities, including real and/or perceived "gaps" in CMPA and HIROC coverage of physician PI research activities.

Unless the insurance "gaps" are addressed, and/or reasonable alternatives identified, research projects (especially investigator-initiated) will be in jeopardy of not proceeding.

RESPONSIBILITIES

To survey the current insurance (and CMPA) coverage applicable to hospitals and physician PIs for clinical research, identify the issues and "gaps", discuss associated risks, propose risk-mitigation strategies, and recommended course(s) of action towards remedying those "gaps".

In performing its review and report, the Task Force may consult with relevant individuals in the TAHSN-member hospitals and/or with other TAHSN groups, as appropriate.
