



J. P. Bickell Foundation Medical Research Grant Application

The J. P. Bickell Foundation Medical Research Grant provides assistance to biomedical scientists of various departments and faculties in Ontario universities, hospitals and scientific institutions concerned with medical research. There will be five to seven applicants chosen from across the province to receive grants of approximately \$25,000 to \$80,000 each.

The J. P. Bickell Foundation will accept one application per qualifying institution. As such, the University of Toronto will be conducting an internal review to select one applicant to go forward with full application.

Your application will be reviewed by a minimum of three (3) members of our internal review panel. This panel will be comprised of University of Toronto faculty members with a medical research background, who have volunteered their time to provide expertise in reviewing your application.

- March 1, 2022: Notice of Intent due date
- March 22, 2022: Internal application due date; an MRA is also required for this application
- April 22, 2022: PIs will be notified of final selection
- April 30, 2022: Final deadline for submission of full application to the J. P. Bickell Foundation
