

NFRF 2022 Transformation Competition – Expressions of Interest

The New Frontiers in Research Fund (NFRF) <u>2022 Transformation</u> <u>competition</u> is now open at the Notice of Intent stage. The NFRF Transformation stream is intended to fund large-scale, Canadian-led interdisciplinary research projects that address a major challenge and have potential to realize real and lasting change.

The Division of the Vice-President, Research and Innovation, seeks to provide support and coordination around emerging Transformation teams and proposals. We are therefore asking all University of Toronto faculty members who are part of a Transformation team intending to submit a Notice of Intent to please complete a brief Expression of Interest form.

Faculty members should complete this form if they will be a Nominated Principal Investigator (NPI), co-Principal Investigator, or co-applicant. Co-PIs and co-applicants are asked to complete the form even if the project team is led by an NPI at another institution. This information will be used to identify potential synergies among teams and to support strategic coordination with the academic divisions.

All Transformation team members are asked to submit the completed <u>Expression of Interest form</u> by **October 15, 2021**.
