The Anne and Max Tanenbaum Chair Program in Biomedical Research

The Temerty Faculty of Medicine is seeking applicants for the Tanenbaum Chair Program. **One** position is available, in Molecular Medicine. The successful candidates must already hold, or be eligible for, a tenure-streamed academic appointment within the Temerty Faculty of Medicine, University of Toronto (U of T), at the rank of Associate or Full Professor. The term of the Chair position is 5 years with the opportunity for one 5-year renewal following a successful review. Applications will be accepted until January 16, 2023, or until filled.

The Anne and Max Tanenbaum Chair Program was established in the mid-1990's through a generous endowment by the Tanenbaum family. The goal of the program is to support biomedical research at the University of Toronto and multiple partner hospitals by providing direct support to exceptional scientists. In the last three decades, the Tanenbaum Chair program has helped to support phenomenal advances in both basic neuroscience and molecular medicine knowledge, and emerging technologies. The next UofT Tanenbaum Chairs are expected to have an active and established research program, with a vision for how their contributions will advance their field.

Another key deliverable of the Tanenbaum Chair Program in Biomedical Research is the annual Tanenbaum Symposium. On a rotational basis with the hospital-based chairs, each incumbent chair is expected to host the symposium at least once during their term. With logistical and financial support from the Office of the Vice Dean, Research & Health Science Education, the chairholder will invite notable researchers to come to the UofT to give a lecture and moderate a panel discussion.

The University of Toronto is strongly committed to diversity within its community and especially where possible welcomes applications from racialized persons/persons of colour, women, Indigenous/Aboriginal People of North America, persons with disabilities, LGBTQ persons, and others who may contribute to further diversification of ideas.

Submission Deadline: January 16, 2023, 5pm EST. Applications must include:

- 1. Letter of Support by the Department Chair,
- 2. a 2-page statement explaining the applicant's current research plan and potential future directions, and
- 3. a CV (any format).

Applicants must be campus-based tenure stream.
